

## **EDNY ENTRY SCREENING PROCEDURES**

ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, including visitors, attorneys, litigants, law enforcement personnel, vendors, and contractors, and all courthouse personnel, must have their temperature taken and complete a questionnaire about their COVID-19 status and possible recent exposure before being allowed entry into any Eastern District of New York courthouse. (Administrative Order 2020-22.)

You may register for the EDNY's screening system, and complete the questionnaire in advance on the day of your visit to speed entry, by clicking on the link below, or scanning the QR Code below with a mobile device camera.

## IF YOUR ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY:

- 1. YOU WILL BE SENT A QR CODE FOR ENTRY THAT DAY THAT MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE EDNY SCREENING DEVICE AT THE COURTHOUSE ENTRANCE.
- 2. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE YOUR TEMPERATURE TAKEN AT THE SCREENING DEVICE UPON ENTRY. Temperature screening will not be permitted unless you complete the questionnaire first.
- 3. YOU WILL THEN PROCEED TO THE SECURITY CHECKPOINT.

IF YOUR ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS <u>DO NOT MEET</u> THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY OR YOU HAVE A TEMPERATURE IN EXCESS OF 100.4 DEGREES:

- 1. YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ENTRY.
- 2. YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE PERSON OR OFFICE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR VISIT.
