Pursuant to the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. §§ 631, *et. seq.*, and the further authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States, and


Whereas the Board of Judges approved the reappointment of Steven M. Gold as a United States Magistrate Judge, it is hereby

ORDERED that Steven M. Gold is reappointed to serve as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of New York, at a salary fixed by the Judicial Conference, and shall continue as United States Magistrate Judge on the 23th of February, 2017, but prior to the commencement of such duties he shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§ 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of the office for a term of eight years from the effective date of this appointment, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i), unless sooner relieved.
