ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-12

The Board of Judges has voted to establish a one-year pilot Pro Se Clinic program using funds donated from non-appropriated funds in accordance with the <u>Guide to Judiciary Policy</u>, Vol. 13, Ch. 12, §1220(f)(2) (see <u>Report of the Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States</u>, March 11, 2014, at 13). The Clinic will be organized, managed and run by the City Bar Justice Center at the Brooklyn Courthouse. The City Bar Justice Center will provide periodic reports to the Board of Judges as to the use and effectiveness of the Clinic.

The Clinic will be established and the pilot will begin as soon as practicable. After a substantial portion of the year-long pilot has concluded, the Board of Judges will review the program for possible renewal.
