
IT FURTHER APPEARING that a magistrate judge of this court has a financial interest in the outcome of the case;

IT FURTHER APPEARING that based upon the above stated circumstance, the impartiality of the United States District Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York might reasonably be questioned;

IT IS THEREFORE DETERMINED that, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 455(a), said United States District Judges of the Eastern District of New York are disqualified from presiding in case 11-CV-509; and

IT WILL THEREFORE BE REQUESTED that the Chief Judge of the Second Circuit Court of Appeals designate a judge from outside the Eastern District of New York but from within the Second Circuit, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 292(b), to perform the duties of United States District Judge temporarily for the Eastern District of New York for the specific case Balik v. New York Institute of Technology, Case No. 11-CV-509 and all related matters.
