Whereas a Merit Selection Panel appointed by the Court recommended the reappointment of Steven M. Gold after public notice, a comment period and review by the Committee, and


Whereas the Board of Judges unanimously approved the reappointment of Steven M. Gold as a United States Magistrate Judge, it is

ORDERED that Steven M. Gold is hereby reappointed to serve as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of New York, at a salary fixed by the Judicial Conference, and shall continue as United States Magistrate Judge on the 23rd of February, 2009, but prior to the commencement of such duties he shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. Sections 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of the office for a term of eight years from the effective date of this appointment, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. Section 631(I), unless sooner relieved.

A certified copy of this Order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as required by 28 U.S.C. Section 631(h).
