PACER FEE EXEMPTION EXTENSION ORDER

INTERD OF AFEC DICEDICE COLDE

The Court received an extension request by Alexander Viets for continued exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

On July 15, 2024, the Court granted Alexander Viets, a researcher at the University of Cambridge, an exemption from the payment of fees for access via PACER until September 30, 2024, because he demonstrated that an exemption was necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Alexander Viets now requests an extension of his prior exemption because he was unable to download all required documents before his exemption expired. Accordingly, Alexander Viets shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching the impact of patent litigation cases on the performance outcomes of U.S. companies. Alexander Viets shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. In addition, the following limitations apply:

- 1. this fee exemption applies only to Alexander Viets (PACER Account # 8034829) and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- 2. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
- 3. by accepting this exemption, Alexander Viets agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption and not to redistribute any data over the internet;
- 4. this exemption is valid until March 31, 2025, unless earlier revoked.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center together with a copy of the application.
