PACER FEE EXEMPTION ORDER

IN HEED OF LEES DISTRICT COLUMN

The Court received an application request by Charlotte Alexander for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

Charlotte Alexander, a professor of law and ethics associated with the Law, Data & Design Lab at the Georgia Tech Scheller College of Business, has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Charlotte Alexander shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching the relationship between the composition of corporate boards and officers and the frequency and types of sexual harassment and sex discrimination cases filed against those companies. Charlotte Alexander shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. In addition, the following limitations apply:

- 1. this fee exemption applies only to Charlotte Alexander (PACER Account # 3917979) and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- 2. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
- 3. by accepting this exemption, Charlotte Alexander agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption and not to redistribute any data over the internet;
- 4. this exemption is valid until November 14, 2025, unless earlier revoked.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center together with a copy of the application.
