ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-04

PACER FEE EXEMPTION ORDER

The Court received an application request by Cat Itaya, Esq., for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

Cat Itaya, Esq., the attorney appointed by the City Bar Justice Center to administer the Eastern District of New York Federal Pro Se Clinic ("FEDPRO Clinic") falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Ms. Itaya has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Ms. Itaya shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her duties at the FEDPRO Clinic. Ms. Itaya shall <u>not</u> be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, all of the following limitations apply:

- 1. This fee exemption applies only to Cat Itaya, Esq., and is valid only for the purposes stated above during the operation of the FEDPRO Clinic.
- 2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files that are available through the PACER system.
- 3. By accepting this exemption, Ms. Itaya agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center together with a copy of the application. The Court also hereby revokes the prior exemption for Nancy Rosenbloom, Esq., as provided for under Administrative Order 2015-04.
