Pursuant to the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. Sections 631, *et. seq.*, and the further authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States, and

Whereas a Merit Selection Panel appointed by the Court recommended the reappointment of Cheryl L. Pollak after public notice, a comment period and review by the Committee, and

Whereas the Board of Judges unanimously approved the reappointment of Cheryl L. Pollak as a United States Magistrate Judge, it is

ORDERED that Cheryl L. Pollak is hereby reappointed to serve as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of New York, at a salary fixed by the Judicial Conference, and shall continue as a United States Magistrate Judge on the 1st day of November, 2011, but prior to the commencement of such duties she shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. Sections 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of the office for a term of eight years from the effective date of this appointment, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. Section 631(i), unless sooner relieved.


