Section 1983, Construction, ERISA, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Fair Debt Collections Act, the Hague Convention, Maritime/Admiralty, and Personal Injury. EDNY panel applicants must complete the application below and submit one letter of reference from a person who has direct knowledge of the applicant's skill as a mediator, and one letter of reference from a person who has direct knowledge of the applicant's legal knowledge and areas of expertise.
